

Pender Island Junior Sailing

2017 Summer Job Posting

The Pender Island Junior Sailing Association is taking applications for the upcoming 2017 summer sailing season. We are looking for two instructors who have a passion for sailing and enjoy passing that on to others, and are qualified to teach CANSail one to four.

Browning Harbour on Pender Island provides a terrific setting to teach dinghy sailing with prevailing light onshore winds, no tidal currents and water that warms in July and August.

Students are predominately 9 through 16 years old; they will be sailing FJs, Laser I and IIs, Bytes -- instructors use Zodiacs.

Three experienced volunteers will assist with launching, storing and repairing boats and act as “eyes on the water” for added safety. VHF radios are used to communicate ship to shore.

Course Dates Are:

July 17 – 21
July 31 – August 4
August 7 – 11
August 21 – 25

Wages begin at \$20 per hour and include travel time for instructors who commute from Swartz Bay or Long Harbour, Salt Spring Island for pick-up at Otter Bay, Pender Island. Overnight accommodation will be arranged for instructors for whom a commute would be inconvenient.

We look forward to receiving your application -- cover letter and resume – and we are confident you will find Pender Island a friendly, low-key place to teach sailing.
